The Dolder Grand Presidential Suites

Each of the Dolder Grand's four Presidential Suites is an expression of distinctive style and extravagant comfort, with a different ambience. The interior design of the suites – each with its own style and character – was inspired by one of the many illustrious guests who have stayed at the Dolder Grand over the years and created by London-based United Designers. The Terrazza Suite, classed as a 'Residence', is the fifth exclusive suite at the Dolder Grand. The prices of the Presidential Suites range from CHF 5,500.00 to CHF 14,600.00 per night.

Maestro Suite

Inspired by Maestro Herbert von Karajan, one of the greatest orchestral conductors of the 20th century; classical music has influenced classical architecture and design. Set in the tower of the Dolder Grand's Main Building, this extraordinary two-floor, two-bedroom Suite offers some 400 square metres of living space. On the lower floor, each of the two bedrooms has its own luxurious bathroom, one in light Bianco Oro marble and the other in dark Portoro marble. In addition to a whirlpool and steam shower, one of the bathrooms features a sauna. Classical in style and circular in shape with a wraparound balcony, the dining room is located in the tower section of this level and can be served from the suite's private kitchen. Also on this level, the library is ideal for reading or working in peace and quiet. On the suite's upper floor, the tower room is the perfect place to relax. The spire's dark red timberwork has been restored to its historic original state and is complemented by the club-like style of the leather armchairs and velvet sofas, as well as a fireplace and private bar. The tower room's spacious covered terrace – the highest vantage point at the Dolder Grand – provides breath taking views of the city of Zurich, the lake and the Alps.

Carezza Suite

Exceptional elegance on the top floor of the Spa Wing: an homage to Alberto Giacometti, the Swiss artist and sculptor. The outstanding feature of the Carezza Suite is its organically shaped fittings and furnishings are suggestive of Giacometti's works of art. The 230-square-metre Suite has two bedrooms, each with a bathroom in white Bianco Lasa Vena Oro marble. In addition to a whirlpool and a steam shower, one of the bathrooms also features a sauna. In the spacious, open-plan living area, large, curving leather sofas and a modern fireplace invite you to linger. The high ceiling and the floor-to-ceiling windows create an expansive sense of space. The dining area can be served from the private, en suite kitchen. There is a separate TV lounge for watching movies and programmes. The terrace, which wraps around the entire suite, offers a fabulous panoramic view of the city of Zurich, the lake and the Alps.

Masina Suite

Inspired by Giulietta Masina, the actress and wife of Federico Fellini. With a touch of the glamour of 1950s cinema, the Masina Suite (170 square metres) on the top floor of the Spa Wing has a distinctive Italian-style interior. Each of the two bedrooms has its own bathroom, clad in dark green Verde Guatemala marble – one of the which also features a sauna and a steam shower. A large, cream-coloured Fendi sofa is the focal point of the spacious living room, where entertainment can be provided by the large flat-screen TV and a pool table. The dining area can be served from the en suite kitchen. The floor-to-ceiling windows create a great sense of space, which is extended by the view from the terrace overlooking high treetops and the lake below.

Suite 100

Inspired by the Rolling Stones and named after London's legendary 100 Club, where many of the world's most famous bands began their careers – and where the Rolling Stones played a secret show in 1982. Extravagantly unconventional in style, Suite 100 (170 square metres) is set on the top floor of the Spa Wing. Its rock'n'roll mood is set by a predominantly black-and-pink decor redolent of the Swinging Sixties. The Suite has one bedroom with a spacious bathroom in black, equipped with a whirlpool, sauna and steam shower. The living room features mid-century style furniture and accessories, and the dining area can be served from the en suite kitchen. Another of the suite's special features is its own meeting room seating 10 people. The floor-to-ceiling windows create a feeling of expansive space and the terrace, which runs the entire length of the suite, offers a view of the historic Main Building, the lake and the Alps.

Residence Terrazza Suite

The Terrazza Suite is especially suited to longer stays for guests who appreciate the highest level of privacy and comfort. Arranged over two floors, it has one master bedroom and the option of three additional bedrooms connected by a private corridor, taking the total space to 390 square metres. Located in the Golf Wing, the Residence has a private entrance directly from outside and another from within the hotel. From the main entrance on the upper level, guests enter a lobby that gives access to an impressively equipped private office and to a glass-walled lift that descends to the lower floor. The expansive open-plan living area is designed and furnished in classically contemporary style, and decorated in warm, harmonious tones. Floor-to-ceiling windows open onto the sunny, south-facing terrace, which has a magnificent view over Lake Zurich. Adjacent to the elegant dining area is a fully equipped private kitchen. The master bedroom also opens onto the terrace and has its own small sitting area in a quiet corner. A walk-through wardrobe leads to the luxurious master bathroom, featuring a steam shower, a large whirlpool tub, and walls decorated with iridescent mother-of-pearl mosaic in a warm shade of brown. Designed to be a home-from-home in Zurich, the Residence Terrazza Suite offers an on-call butler service 24 hours a day.
