Floating Poetry: Christmas in the Spirit of Charles Kaisin

Charles Kaisin transforms the Dolder Grand Spa into a suspended composition of light, form and symbolism. 1,200 golden origami doves trace the silhouette of a contemporary Christmas tree.

Floating from the ceiling, it comes alive with the gentlest movement of air or a guest's step – a delicate shimmer setting it in motion like a softly murmuring flock. 1,200 hand-folded origami doves form an image of peace.

The gold of the birds stands for thoughts, dreams and intentions that take shape in the new year – a symbol of infinite creative potential. Suspended on red threads, this installation lends the festive season strength and joy."

About the Dolder Grand

The Dolder Grand is a 175-room city resort nestled in the hills overlooking the vibrant lakeside city of Zurich and the picturesque Swiss Alps. The Dolder Spa is over 4,000 sq meters and features an expansive indoor pool, hot and cold plunge pools, sauna, steam, aroma pool, solarium, snow room, meditation room, a sun-soaked outdoor terrace, and more. The Dolder Grand (2 Michelin keys) is a member of The Leading Hotels of the World, Swiss Deluxe Hotels and Responsible Hotels of Switzerland.
